## Recent Drug Formulary Updates: Effective September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

- **Fluticasone/salmeterol** (generic AirDuo Respiclick©) has been added to formulary without a prior authorization for asthma in patients 12 and older. All strengths are included: **55mcg/14mcg, 113mcg/14mcg, and 232mcg/14mcg**
- **Fluticasone/salmeterol** (generic Advair Diskus©) has been added to formulary without a prior authorization for asthma and chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD) in patients 4 years and older. Only the **100mcg/50mcg and 250mcg/50mcg** are included. The 500mcg/50mcg will require a prior authorization.
- There is a new quantity and day supply limit on doxycycline 100mg capsules. The new quantity and day supply limits are 180 capsules for up to a 90 day supply every 365 days.

## Effective November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021

- Flovent Diskus© (fluticasone), Qvar Redihaler© (beclomethasone), and Alvesco© (ciclesonide) will be the only formulary inhaled corticosteroids (ICS) and will not require a prior authorization.
- Flovent HFA© (fluticasone), Asmanex© (mometasone), and Pulmicort© (budesonide) will be non-formulary and require a prior authorization.
